

We all want to go deeper with God, but few of us want to step out into the water.

Going deeper with God means falling more in love with Him each day. But going deeper means stepping out into the uncomfortable places of deep water.

Are we willing to go deeper with God? Are we willing to be led by the Spirit to where God is calling us?

Going to the deeper places involves us going into uncertain, uncomfortable places.

Matthew 14:22-33

The Boat

The boat is a place of comfort. It is the place where the disciples felt the most comfortable even when the wind and waves were beating against it.

Eleven disciples stayed in the boat, but Peter attempted to go to Jesus.

Jesus gives a simple invitation to Peter - "Come"

"Come" is an invitation to come out into something deeper, and something less comfortable.

The Water

The water is the uncertainty. Sometimes Jesus calls us to the shore from the water and sometimes Jesus calls us to the water from a place of comfort.

We may be leaving our comfort, but we are called to the place that Jesus is at.

The Master

The uncertain places draw us to a place of closeness to God. Sometimes we feel that we will fail when we step out in faith, but the moment that we fall, Jesus is ready to pick us up.
